Ongoing learning updates	2.1 School field trips and fees	Brooke	School Based fees: School Field Trips and Fees - Last year noticing that families were having trouble paying fees (for a number of different reasons (online process, economy etc)). This year moving forward we're making a few changes: - Only 2 offsite or 2 inclass (or the combination) activities per year - (In addition) swimming for grades 1-3 - All other residencies and opportunities to be supported by VASPFS - By October sharing the expected costs with families for the year - Teachers may still have presentations, excursions etc that don't have costs - VASPFS created a budget for the school to support families who need help with fees associated with trips/presentation. This is anonymous only office would communicate with families. This is a process that can cover some/all costs for those who need it. Central fees - There is a waiver that you can apply for to waive these fees if needed. This is controlled by CBE - not the school - Includes: buses, lunch supervision and, ISM - school fees

Principal Updates and Reports	3.1 Staffing	Brooke	First three days back summary (August - teachers only) - Purpose: set intentions for the year, set up classrooms, think about how to welcome students in - TED video: Getting it right - why pronouncing names matter. Teachers shared stories about their own names, about being called the wrong name. Teachers then were asked to design a first day task involving names to build belonging. Staffing Updates Gr 5 Mme. Amamatou Nkap temporary teacher for Stefanie Johnson who is on maternity leave Gr 5 - Mr. Josh Cormier is a probationary teacher Gr 4 Mme Lyna Zamani is in for Mme Kate Maclachlan who is on a parental leave. Mme Zamani was in grade 1 last year. Gr 4 Mme. Sara Whyte is in for Mme Megan Trosch who is on maternity leave. Mme whyte was in last year as a literacy intervention teacher for grade 1. Gr 4 Monsieur "Bob" Bobekeur Ait Salah is on a probationary contract in grade 4.		

	Mme. Forbes is 0.8 (doesn't work on Fridays) Up-to date list of teachers can be found on the school website. Open education assistant position that needs to be filled (early October) based on money for enrollment. Halyna Kinasevych who was with us last year retired.
3.2 Enrollment and ongoing registration	 Enrollment and ongoing registration Current 558 students. Down from where we budgeted at and projections. We anticipated we wouldn't meet projections, but still lower than expected. Still space in kindergarten and grade 1. Registration is ongoing for k throughout the year (although we understand that child care in difficult). Seeds of Spice is moving the k classroom Nov 1 to a different site. The gr 1-5 will remain at Varsity. Any questions about this you are encouraged to reach out to Seeds of Spice directly. Confirm in early October final numbers and then final budget School budget is firstly based on spring RAM - this is the planning phase and then finalized with the count on September 30. Depending on what other students come in before September 30 and in what grades this could change classes. Final updates will be available in October. 7. 3 Treasurer's Report	Treasurer's Report - \$ 39700 internal - \$ 46000 casino - 10k of cheques not deposited yet - Last casino was aug 2024 - have 2 years to spend 46k should not be a problem - Got 83k the last one and the one before 72k - This year have spent a bit over 100k in the school (20 k for furniture and the av system). - Healthy hunger - used to make 5k a year. Last year was \$1100 due to reduced volunteers so reduced number of Healthy Hunger lunches. Q - VASPFS is not a registered charity. The Cbe has a process but it takes awhile if you just want to donate.
