 deliver on the goals outlined.

• Each month, there are extra fees required for every activity, School lunch supervision... we pay the same amount per month regardless of whether half the month is spent at home (i.e. December). School fees are out of control, and although we have no issue paying them, we recognize many families do not have these options. Also, the "artist in residence" is not a good use of funds.

- The students have lots of great experiences through the school. Teacher's Pet is too expensive for what it offers, and when teachers can do the same thing, but other fees that we're charged are worth it. Thank you.
- School fees for Artists, Field Trips and other enrichment programs add up quickly. With two students at the school, these fees, with lunch supervision, are getting expensive. I feel like I have no choice but to pay these fees and that there are assumptions made by teachers and administrators or school council that parents can afford these and there is not a lot of conversation or consideration of the overall, cumulative cost. I appreciate my children have the opportunity to do these things, but perhaps one or two a year, not multiple. Ie. Teacher's Pet, Clay for Kids, Youth Singers, Multiple Field trips, etc. They don't need all of these. It feels like there is an assumption that parents in our community can, or want to, pay for these multiple expenses.
